

**SAUK CENTRE CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING  
FRIDAY, MAY 1, 2009 – 11:00 A.M.**

**1. CALL TO ORDER/ ROLL CALL/ PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

The Sauk Centre City Council met in a Special Meeting on Friday, May 1, 2009 at 11:00 a.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers pursuant to due notice being given thereof. Present were Mayor Brad Kirckof, Council Members David Thomas, Keith Johnson, Al Coenen and Warren Stone. Also present was City Administrator Vicki Willer, City Planner Sarah Morton Police Chief Bryon Friedrichs and Administrative Assistant Nicki Vogt. Mayor Kirckof presided thereat.

**2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA.**

The agenda was approved as presented.

**3. ACTION ITEMS**

Tina Rohde dba Mustang Bar made a request for a Temporary Outdoor Liquor Permit for beer pong and music for the weekend of May 1 – 2, 2009. They will have two security personnel on hand to insure that liquor does not leave the fenced area (25' x 50'). Neighboring business owners, Gary Winters and Jackie Mead have been informed of the event with no objection. They have provided the following items:

- Outdoor Liquor Permit Application
- Proof of Liquor Liability coverage that extends to the parking lot behind the bar
- \$150.00 Special Meeting fee
- \$50.00 application fee

Staff made the recommendation that if approved, the following conditions be considered with approval:

1. Alcohol to be dispensed in non-glass containers
2. Area to be fenced with no alcohol permitted outside fenced area
3. Outside music be turned off at 10:00

Police Chief Friedrichs stated that the Police Department does not condone drinking games unless sober cabs are provided. He is also concerned with the noise issue. He suggested that there be security outside the entire time and that 18 year olds be clearly marked.

Tina Rohde stated that the reason she is requesting the outdoor permit is because she was contacted by a group that is interested in having their birthday party at her establishment. She will leave the fencing up the entire weekend. She also stated that sober cabs will be available, no minors will be allowed and if noise complaints are received she will turn the music down and have people moved inside. She then requested that the Council approve music to allow music to be available till 12:00 a.m.

A motion was made by Council Member Stone and was seconded by Council Member Johnson to approve the Temporary Outdoor Liquor Permit for the Mustang Bar for beer pong and music for the dates of May 1-2, 2009 with the following conditions applied: 1. Alcohol to be dispensed in non-glass containers, 2. Area to be fenced with no alcohol permitted outside of fenced area, 3. Outside music to be turned off by 12:00 a.m. A vote being recorded as follows: For: Council Member Stone, Johnson, Thomas. Against: Council Member Coenen. Abstain: Mayor Kirckof (Reason: Personal). The motion passed.

**4. ADJOURNMENT**

A motion was made by Council Member Stone and was seconded by Council Member Thomas to adjourn the meeting. A vote being recorded as follows: For: Council Members Stone, Thomas, Johnson, Coenen and Mayor Kirckof. Against: None. The motion passed.

With no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Kirckof recessed the meeting at 11:23 a.m.
