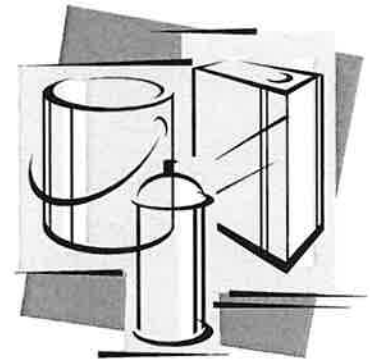

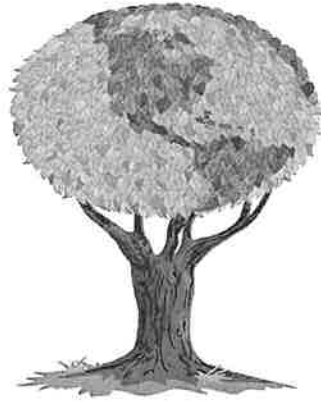

**NOTICE OF BRUSH AND COMPOST DISPOSAL  
FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE  
CITY OF SAUK CENTRE**

To accommodate residents within the city limits, the Sauk Centre Street Department will be open during daylight hours.

**This is a Permit of Rule Yard Waste Compost Facility under MPCA Permit #2Y-00003. In order to continue this “FREE” service to the residents within the City of Sauk Centre, we need to be restrictive in what types of materials can be disposed of at these two sites. Please help us by following the guidelines established in order to keep the facility open.**

**SITE 1: COMPOST** – Leaves, grass clippings and garden materials only. No cardboard, plastic bags, wood materials or other solid waste materials.

**SITE 2: BRUSH** – Only branches, brush, shrubs and other wood materials less than 6” in diameter. Lumber, building materials, cardboard, plastic, metals, stumps or other wood larger than 6” in diameter can **NOT** be accepted. There is a solid waste facility located just south of Sauk Centre on Highway #71 for your convenience.

**PLEASE REMEMBER TO SEPARATE YOUR MATERIALS!**

In addition, feel free to utilize the finished mulch products from composting. Mulch works very well for tree planting, gardens, flowerbeds and in lawn establishment. Wood chips are also available for your use.
