A NOTE FROM CITY OF SAUK CENTRE FIRE CHIEF

There have been many questions about camp or recreational fires, if they are permitted in City limits? Yes, they are permitted but **ONLY** vegetative material. A camp or recreational fire can be no bigger than three (3) feet in diameter by three (3) feet high and has had the ground five (5) feet from the base of the fire cleared of all combustible material and no closer than fifty (50) feet to any structure. Another frequently asked question; are burning barrels allowed? No, according to the City Ordinance, burning barrels are not allowed. You can be fined up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for using a burning barrel, burning anything else other than vegetative material or if you are burning without a burning permit. The burning of leaves is not permitted within the City of Sauk Centre. Please take your leaves to the City compost site, located on 1st Street North.
